Questions for Barnett:

HIGH RISK

- O Water is leaking from my hot water tank Rings or discoloration on the floor can be signs of a leak.
- O There's corrosion on the fittings or pipes going into or out of my tank

 Corrosion can make the pipe or fittings look green, white, or rust
- O My water heater is 6 years old or older Look for the manufacture date printed on a sticker on the tank.

MEDIUM RISK

O I run out of hot water quickly Can you take a nice, long, hot shower?

- O Discolored water comes out of my faucets *Is your hot water as clear as your cold water?*
- O I have less hot water pressure
 Run just cold water and then just hot water out of a faucet.
 Does the hot water seem to have less pressure?
- O My water heater makes unusual noises
 Popping, hammering, screeching, or sizzling can be a problem.
 An occasional ticking noise is normal.

LOW RISK

O My water heater temperature dial is set higher than "medium"

A water heater set to "high" is inefficient. It's not risky, it's just expensive.

Maintenance You Should Be Doing on Your Hot Water Heater

► Flush the tank every year
